



Summer Camp Carpenter Job Description

As the Carpenter at Perry-Mansfield School and Camp in Steamboat Springs, CO, you construct sets for four theatre shows in two spaces. In addition, you will construct set pieces for dance productions as needed. You will attend weekly production meetings.

Previous experience as a Carpenter Must have the ability to be flexible and have strong communication skills. Specific responsibilities are listed below. Qualified Carpenter will be able to teach in the summer production program.

Responsibilities

- Constructing sets for three Theatre production
- Constructing set pieces for Dance productions as needed
- Prepare needed materials for productions
- Work with the Technical Director to order needed materials
- Attend weekly production meetings
- Attend rehearsals are required.
- Supervise load-in and load-outs of sets
- Other duties as assigned

Qualifications

- Previous experience as a Carpenter
- Knowledge of tools necessary to construct set pieces
- Experience using tools needed to construct set pieces, including, but not limited to, table and hand saws, other handheld tools, and paint supplies.
- Ability to be flexible
- Strong communication skills

Physical Requirements

- Must be able to stand for long periods.
- Must be able to walk for long periods.
- Must be able to lift and carry a minimum of 50 pounds.
- Must be able to bend, stretch, and reach for extended periods.

Hours

The hours will vary during camp, depending on the show schedule. Late nights and weekends will be required.

Compensation

This seasonal position runs from June 1 – August 5 (starting and end dates are flexible.) Compensation is \$800 - \$1,000 per week DOE. Room and board are available for this position.
