



Summer Camp Scenic Designer Job Description Updated 3-2024

Scenic Designer

As scenic designer at Perry Mansfield School & Camp in Steamboat Springs, CO, you will work closely with artistic teams to design multiple shows in two spaces over the summer. You will attend 2-3 rehearsals daily, six days a week, and weekly production meetings.

Previous experience as a Scenic Designer and working on shows is a must. Must have the ability to be flexible and have strong communication skills—specific responsibilities listed below. Qualified scene designers will be able to teach in the summer production program.

Responsibilities

- Reading scripts and working with the artistic team to determine the needs of the show
- Presenting designs and communicating them effectively via sketches, 3D software, or model boxes
- Produce ground plans, sections, and elevations for the scene shop
- Assist production staff to build and paint scenery
- Attend production meetings
- Communicate with T.D. and the director about any design changes
- Attend tech and dress rehearsals
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- Previous experience as a Scenic Designer
- Ability to be flexible
- Strong communication skills

Physical Requirements

- Must be able to stand for long periods.
- Must be able to walk for long periods.
- Must be able to lift and carry a minimum of 50 pounds.
- Must be able to bend, stretch, and reach for extended periods.

Hours

The hours will vary during camp, depending on the show schedule. Late nights and weekends will be required.

Compensation

This seasonal position runs from June 9 – August 5 (starting and end dates are flexible.) Compensation is \$550 - \$750 per week DOE. Room and board are included with this position.
