As the sound designer/engineer at Perry Mansfield School & Camp in Steamboat Springs, CO, you will design and record all sound requirements for productions in multiple spaces. Qualified sound designers/engineers will have the opportunity to teach in the summer production program.

Previous experience as a Sound Designer/Engineer is required. Must have the ability to be flexible and have strong communication skills. Specific responsibilities are listed below. Qualified Sound Designers will be able to teach in the summer production program.

Responsibilities

- Setting up sound equipment in each space and
- Troubleshooting issues as they arise,
- Attend tech and dress rehearsals
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- Previous experience as a Sound Designer/Engineer
- Ability to be flexible
- Strong communication skills

Physical Requirements

- Must be able to stand for long periods.
- Must be able to walk for long periods.
- Must be able to lift and carry a minimum of 50 pounds.
- Must be able to bend, stretch, and reach for extended periods.

Hours

The hours will vary during camp, depending on the show schedule. Late nights and weekends will be required.

Compensation

This seasonal position runs from May 26 – August 18 (starting and end dates are flexible.) Compensation is \$400 - \$600 per week DOE. Room and board are available for this position.
