As Swing Tech at Perry Mansfield School and Camp, Steamboat Springs, CO., you must have a strong working knowledge of general theatre practices and be capable of working with various production depts. including (but not limited to) scene shop, electrics, props, and paint.

Previous experience in this role and supervising a crew is required. Must have the ability to be flexible and have strong communication skills. Specific responsibilities are listed below.

Responsibilities

- Assist designers with finding and retrieving stock scenery and props,
- Scenery construction
- Painting
- Running crew during tech rehearsals and shows,
- Assist with load-in and strike of scenery, props, and electrics,
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- Previous experience production experience in a variety of roles, including scenery, props, lighting, and sound
- Experience supervising run crew.
- Ability to be flexible
- Strong communication skills

Physical Requirements

- Must be able to stand for long periods.
- Must be able to walk for long periods.
- Must be able to lift and carry a minimum of 50 pounds.
- Must be able to bend, stretch, and reach for extended periods.

Hours

The hours will vary during camp, depending on the show schedule. Late nights and weekends will be required.

Compensation

This seasonal position runs from May 26 – August 18 (starting and end dates are flexible.) Compensation is \$500 - \$800 per week DOE. Room and board are available for this position.
